WINEMAKER NOTES

DISPLAYING A CAPTIVATINGLY DEEP RUBY, THE 2021 STAGS LEAP DISTRICT CABERNET SAUVIGNON EMERGES WITH A VIBRANT AND GENEROUS BOUQUET. THE AROMATIC PROFILE SHOWCASES A HARMONIOUS BLEND OF RIPE RED AND VIBRANT BLUE FRUITS. UPON SIPPING, IT UNFURLS A MODERATE BODY THAT MASTERFULLY STRIKES AN EXQUISITE EQUILIBRIUM BETWEEN ITS LIVELY ACIDITY AND VELVETY TANNINS. IN THE TRADITION OF BORDEAUX, IT MAINTAINS AN AIR OF LIGHTNESS, FRESHNESS AND A REMARKABLY APPROACHABLE CHARACTER.
